- ABSOLUTELY NO STOPPING ALONG PARADE ROUTE KEEP MOVING.
- 4. Absolutely no candy or other items will be thrown or dropped from the float or vehicle.
- 5. Getting on and off vehicles or floats is STRICTLY prohibited.
- 6. No loud noises, including but not limited to revving engines, burnouts, backfiring and offensively loud or inappropriate music.
- 7. Fire extinguisher must be on the vehicle or float.
- 8. All parade entrants must obey law enforcement directions Roswell Police Department or Chaves County Sheriff's Department
- 9. Neither MainStreet Roswell, the Holiday Light Parade nor the City of Roswell will be held responsible for any accident or injury resulting from the parade.
