PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING RULES TO AVOID DISQUALIFICATION FROM THE PARADE

1. Floats will **LINE UP** on Grand Avenue in front of the Wool Bowl, travel South to College Avenue and South on Main Street. Disbursing at 3rd Street and Richardson at Billy Ray's parking lot.
2. Parade starts at 6:00pm SHARP!
3. ABSOLUTELY NO STOPPING ALONG PARADE ROUTE – KEEP MOVING.
4. Absolutely no candy or other items will be thrown or dropped from the float or vehicle.
5. Getting on and off vehicles or floats is STRICTLY prohibited.
6. No loud noises, including but not limited to revving engines, burnouts, backfiring and offensively loud or inappropriate music.
7. Fire extinguisher must be on the vehicle or float.
8. All parade entrants must obey law enforcement directions – Roswell Police Department or Chaves County Sheriff’s Department
9. Neither MainStreet Roswell, the Holiday Light Parade nor the City of Roswell will be held responsible for any accident or injury resulting from the parade.
